Message from the **PRESIDENT & CEO**



For the Capital Region Minority Supplier Development Council, 2021 became an extension of 2020. Although 2020 caught the world by surprise, and CRMSDC pivoted to accommodate our stakeholders, we still did not know what was in store for us.

Entering 2021, the global economy transfigured and was on lockdown. It positions the Agency to illuminate the root causes of disparity, convene and mobilize the minority business community, serve as an advocate of MBEs within the government, and marshal resources toward programs and initiatives that accelerate the growth of MBEs. Our relationship with MBDA has pivoted as well. As we wrap up our five-plus year grant commitment with the operation of our MBDA Business Center DC and the Federal Procurement Center, we have been given the opportunity to open and manage a historic center for the agency. We are excited to make this part of our legacy.

The CRMSDC Team continues to be second to none. With more than 200 years of combined history in this space, I am very proud of them. This work could not be done without their unwavering commitment to excellence for our corporate members and MBEs. They are second to none!




